APRI – The National A. Philip Randolph Institute was founded 1965 by Asa Philip Randolph and Byard Rustin. The institute has several missions in mind: 1) Bridge the gap between Labor and the African American Community; 2) To encourage African Americans to join the labor unions; 3) Support Civil Rights, Workers Rights, and Human Justice Rights For All; 4) Additionally the institutes mission was Voter Registration, Voter Education, 5) Voter Mobilization and Turning out the votes on Election Day; and 6) Coalition Building with various other groups with issues of mutual concerns. The APRI began forming chapters across the country in the late 1960's and early 1970's. This challenge was issued by Mr. Randolph to mostly all Black Labor Leaders.

CBTU –The Coalition of Black Trade Unions was founded September of 1972 in Chicago when 1200+ black union officials and rank in file members, representing thirty-seven different international and national unions met to discuss the role of black trade unionist in the labor movement. CBTU has enhanced the influence and power of black workers in the trade union movement, helped to open more union leadership positions for women, African Americans and other minorities, increased involvement in voter registration, civil rights and supporting black youth to reduce youth crime. As the 21st century dawns, CBTU is proud to have existed longer than other African American labor organization in history.
